



Breathe Easy Munster

The Town of Munster is breathing easier now, because of the new Smoke-Free Air Ordinance 1780.

Starting November 18, 2019, smoking and vaping is prohibited in the Town of Munster.



The following businesses patronized by the public shall be smoke-free, including but not limited to the following places:

- Aquariums, galleries, libraries and museums
- Banks, professional offices, retail and laundromats establishments
- Bars, bingo, private clubs and gaming facilities
- Childcare and adult day care facilities
- Convention facilities and elevators
- Educational facilities, both public and private, chambers, places of meeting or public assembly, polling places including school buildings, health care facilities
- Hotels, motels, lobbies, hallways, and restaurants; restrooms, lobbies, reception areas, hallways, and other common-use areas
- Apartment buildings, condominiums, trailer parks and retirement facilities, nursing homes, and other multiple-unit residential facilities
- Public transportation vehicles, buses, taxicabs, ticket, boarding, and waiting areas of public transportation, train, and airport facilities, including buses
- Retail stores, shopping malls
- Sports arenas and outdoor arenas
- Theaters, stages and similar performances areas
- Tobacco specialty bars and tobacco retail stores

Product use prohibited in public places in the Town of Munster

- Electronic Smoking Devices
- Any product containing or delivering nicotine or any other substance intended for human consumption. Any devices used by a person to simulate smoking through inhalation of vapor or aerosol.
- These include any such devices as e-cigarette, e-cigar, e-pipe, e-hookah, stig, or vape pen or under any other product name or descriptor.

Public Entrances

- No Smoking outside within fifteen (15) feet
- Smoking shall also be prohibited in and within fifteen (15) feet of bleachers and grandstands for use by spectators at sporting and other public events
